Primary Data Exchanges

The primary data exchanges between the State's Attorney's Office and the Circuit Clerk's Office will include the creation of Felony or Misdemeanor cases, Amended Charges, Court Scheduling and Sentencing / Disposition notifications.

The primary difference between Misdemeanor and Felony cases is in workflow, not data transfer.

Where applicable, the Global Justice XML standards will be incorporated into Lake County justice data exchanges.

XML Requests to the Circuit Clerk's System

- 1. To add a Case (Information or indictment).
- 2. To inherit a Case from the Circuit Clerk's System.
- 3. To verify the existence of a case using citation number, charge document and arresting agency.
- 4. To file an Information on an existing case.
- 5. To file an Indictment on an existing case.
- 6. To file Amended Information.

XML Requests from Circuit Clerk's System

- 1. To push Misdemeanor cases.
- 2. To push court minutes.
- 3. To push any *sentencing* order pertaining to the State's Attorney's Office.
