

ICJIA REQUESTS PROPOSALS FOR FFY07 JUVENILE ACCOUNTABILITY BLOCK GRANT FUNDING

The Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority (ICJIA) is requesting proposals from units of government that were engaged in ICJIA-funded Juvenile Accountability Block Grant programs on May 5, 2011, have already received federal fiscal year 2007 Juvenile Accountability Block Grant funding, and are seeking to enhance or maintain operations within their program's purpose area.

Available funds: A minimum of \$197,884 in FFY07 JABG funding is available. ICJIA will designate a maximum of \$30,000 per award to grantees for the purchase of equipment, software, training, commodities, or other items or services that will directly enhance or maintain the operations of their currently funded JABG program. This award will not pay for vehicles. ICJIA reserves the right to make final determination on what items directly enhance or maintain program operations.

Grant funds may not be used for more than 90 percent of the total cost of the equipment. The remaining 10 percent must be met through a cash match from non-federal sources.

Eligibility: These grants are available only to local-use, ICJIA-funded FFY07 JABG programs that were operating on May 5, 2011.

How to apply: Applications are available at www.icjia.state.il.us. Apply online and submit electronically. Prior to submitting an application, applicants must obtain a DUNS number from Dun and Bradstreet. Go to www.dunandbradstreet.com. Also required prior to application submission is registration with the Central Contractor Registration (CCR) database. To register, go to <http://www.ccr.gov>

Deadline: Proposals are due by 11:59 p.m. on July 30, 2011.
