The Budget Committee approved the use of \$3,500,000 across all Violence Against Women Act (VAWA) open awards to issue a Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) for the solicitation of applications for Domestic Violence and Sexual Assault Multi-Disciplinary Teams (MDT) programs, with the program period scheduled to begin January 1, 2023.
