### **<u>Eligibility</u>**:

#### **Question**

We had been made aware of the Justice Assistance Grant funding opportunity from a couple of our community partners as *Community Organization A* serves as the public transit provider in several of the counties listed in the webinar.

Just wanting to confirm that a *Community Organization A* in our instance, would be eligible to apply?

#### **Response**

1. Eligible Applicants

Eligible organizations are local units of government in rural counties of Illinois. For a complete list of eligible rural areas, please see Appendix A.

There are two options: Is *Community Organization A* a local unit of government? If yes, then you are eligible to apply. If no, then, then the second option is partnering with a local unit of government – whereas the local unit of government would be the primary applicant and *Community Organization A* would be a collaborative partner.
