Do we have to budget the same staff and operations line items in the later 12-month budget that we are budgeting in the 3-month budget for Apr-Jun. E.G. if we don't have a supplies line item in the 3-month budget, can we have a supplies line item in the subsequent 12-months budget, if awarded?

### **Response**

Memorandums of Understanding (MOUs) should be between the application organization and Chicago Police Department, (NOFO 2162-2012, pg. 9). Further, on page 1 of the funding opportunity it states that MOUs should document the support and cooperation of the local law enforcement, county, or municipal agency which will notify the applicant of the homicide.

# **Budget:**



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### Question

According to the NOFO, our organization falls within the tier 2 funding category which means we can apply for up to \$350,000. Please provide clarity on the following:

If we applied for \$350,000 and were awarded \$350,000, would the grant amount cover the initial three-month period (April, May, and June of 2022)?

If awarded \$350,000 for the initial three-month period, and then awarded funding for the next 33months, would the \$350,000 awarded for the initial three-month period be annualized? Which means we would receive an annualized amount of \$1,400,000 (\$350,000x4)?

### **Response**

Thank you for your question. The amount of \$350,000 is for a 12-month budget. The initial funding period of 3 months (April, May, and June of 2022) would be for a quarter of the \$350,000.
