




### % Type of Cases Rated as 'Major Contributor' to Workload - by County Classification











### % ACTION WOULD REDUCE VIOLENCE - BY COUNTY CLASSIFICATION
























### % Management Information Systems or System Modules 'Needs Major Improvement' or 'Needs to be Developed' – by County Classification



### % Types of Incidents Rated as 'Major Contributor' to Workload - by County Classification






### % Drug Enforcement Approach rated 'Needs Major Improvement' or 'Needs to be Developed' – by County Classification





# % Training Areas 'Needs Major Improvement' or 'Needs to be Developed' - by County Classification



# % Rating Field Operations Activities as 'Needs Major Improvement' or 'Needs to be Developed' – by County Classification





# % Management Information Systems / System Modules Rated as 'Needs Major Improvement', 'Needs to be Developed' – by County Classification





# % Probation Services Rated as 'Major Contributor' to Office's Workload – by County Classification





#### % ACTION WOULD REDUCE ILLICIT DRUG USE - BY COUNTY CLASSIFICATION



#### % ACTION WOULD REDUCE VIOLENCE - BY COUNTY CLASSIFICATION



#### % Problems are Getting Worse - by County Classification



### % RATING 'MAJOR INCREASE NEEDED' - BY COUNTY CLASSIFICATION



### % RATING 'MAJOR CONTRIBUTOR' TO RETENTION - BY COUNTY CLASSIFICATION





#### % STATING ASSESSMENT TOOLS NEED TO BE DEVELOPED



# % RATING CONTRACTED SERVICE AS 'NEEDS MAJOR IMPROVEMENT' - BY COUNTY CLASSIFICATION



# % RATING CONTRACTED SERVICE AS 'NEEDS TO BE DEVELOPED' - BY COUNTY CLASSIFICATION



# % RATING PROBATION PROGRAM AS 'NEEDS MAJOR IMPROVEMENT' - BY COUNTY CLASSIFICATION



### % RATING PROBATION PROGRAM AS 'NEEDS TO BE DEVELOPED' - BY COUNTY CLASSIFICATION





### % RATING POLICIES AND PROCEDURES AS 'NEEDS TO BE DEVELOPED' - BY COUNTY CLASSIFICATION



#### % REPORTING 'DRUG TEST IS NOT PERFORMED' BY COUNTY CLASSIFICATION





## % Training Areas 'Needs Major Improvement' or 'Needs to be Developed' - by County Classification










#### % Management Information Systems or System Modules 'Needs Major Improvement' or 'Needs to be Developed' – by County Classification






# % Type of State's Attorney Cases Rated as 'Major Contributor' to Workload – by County Classification










% ACTION WOULD REDUCE VIOLENCE



#### % PROBLEMS ARE GETTING WORSE - BY COUNTY CLASSIFICATION





# % Staff Positions 'Major Increase Needed' or 'Needs to be Developed' – by County Classification









### % Pretrial Practices 'Needs Major Improvement' or 'Needs to be Developed' – by County Classification







#### % Management Information Systems or System Modules 'Needs Major Improvement' or 'Needs to be Developed' – by County Classification



#### % Types of Crime/Incidents Rated as 'Major Contributor' to Workload - by County Classification






### % Service Needs Rated as 'Major Contributor' to Office Workload - by County Classification


