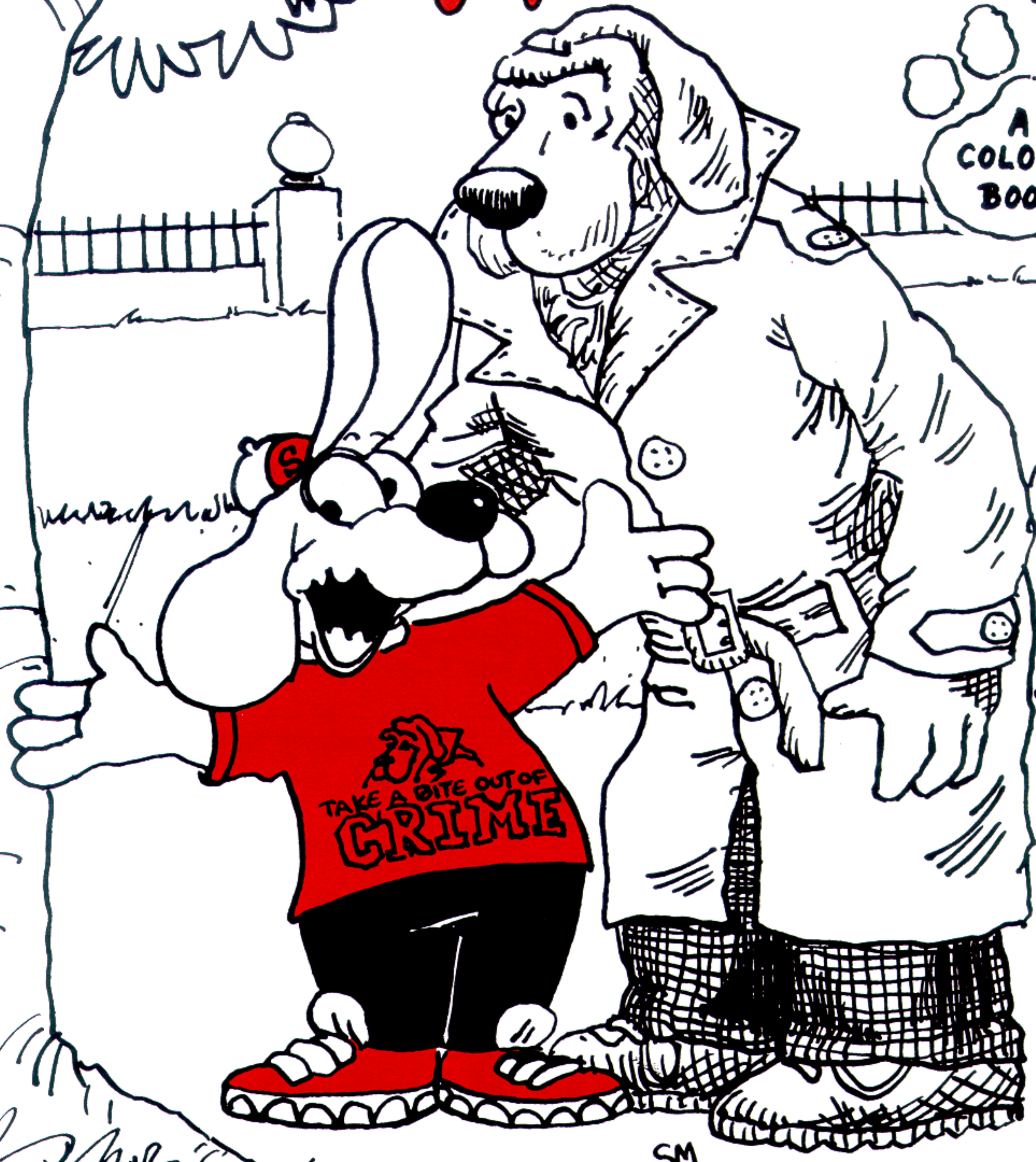

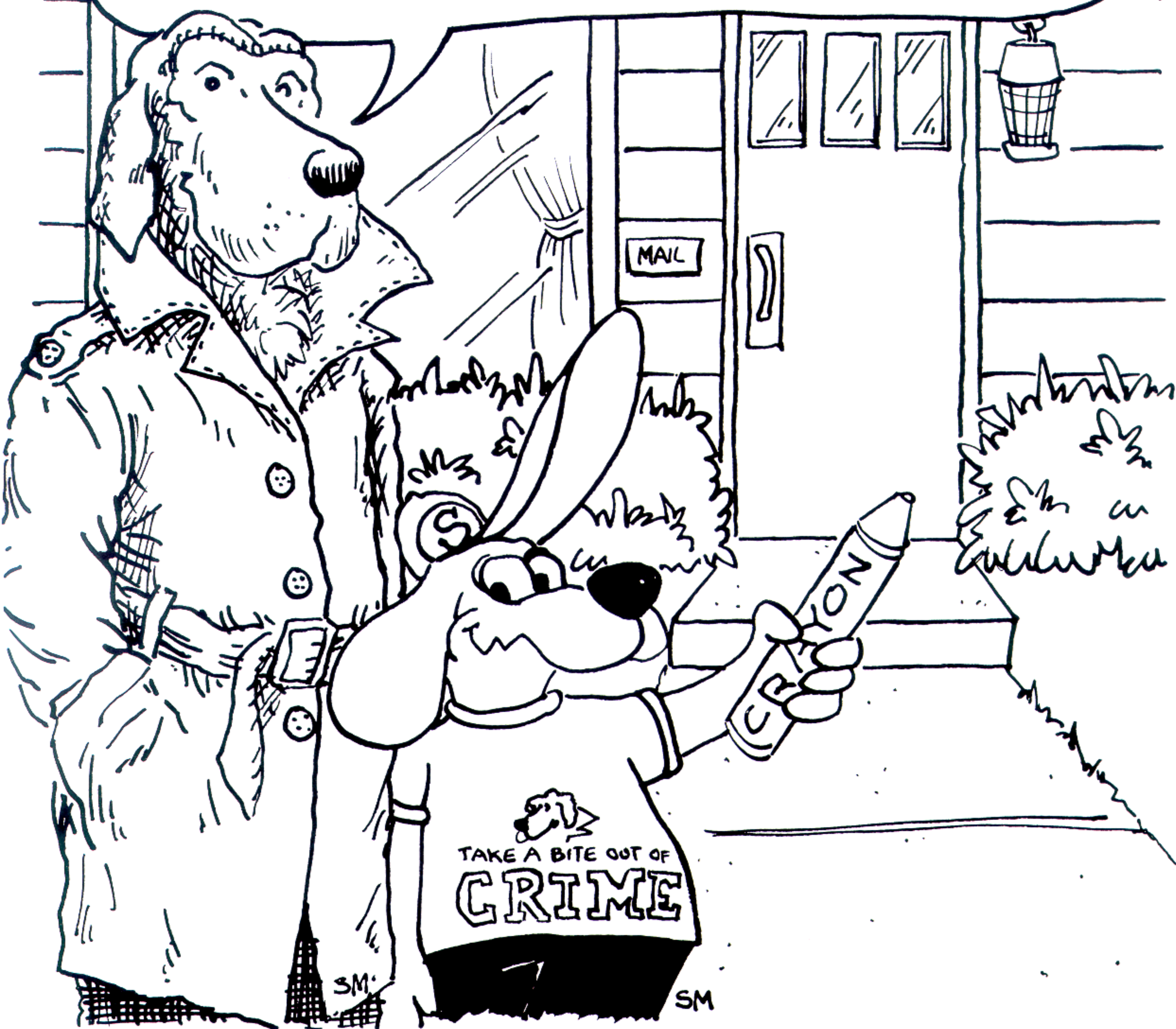

Let's Learn how to "PLAY IT SAFE!"

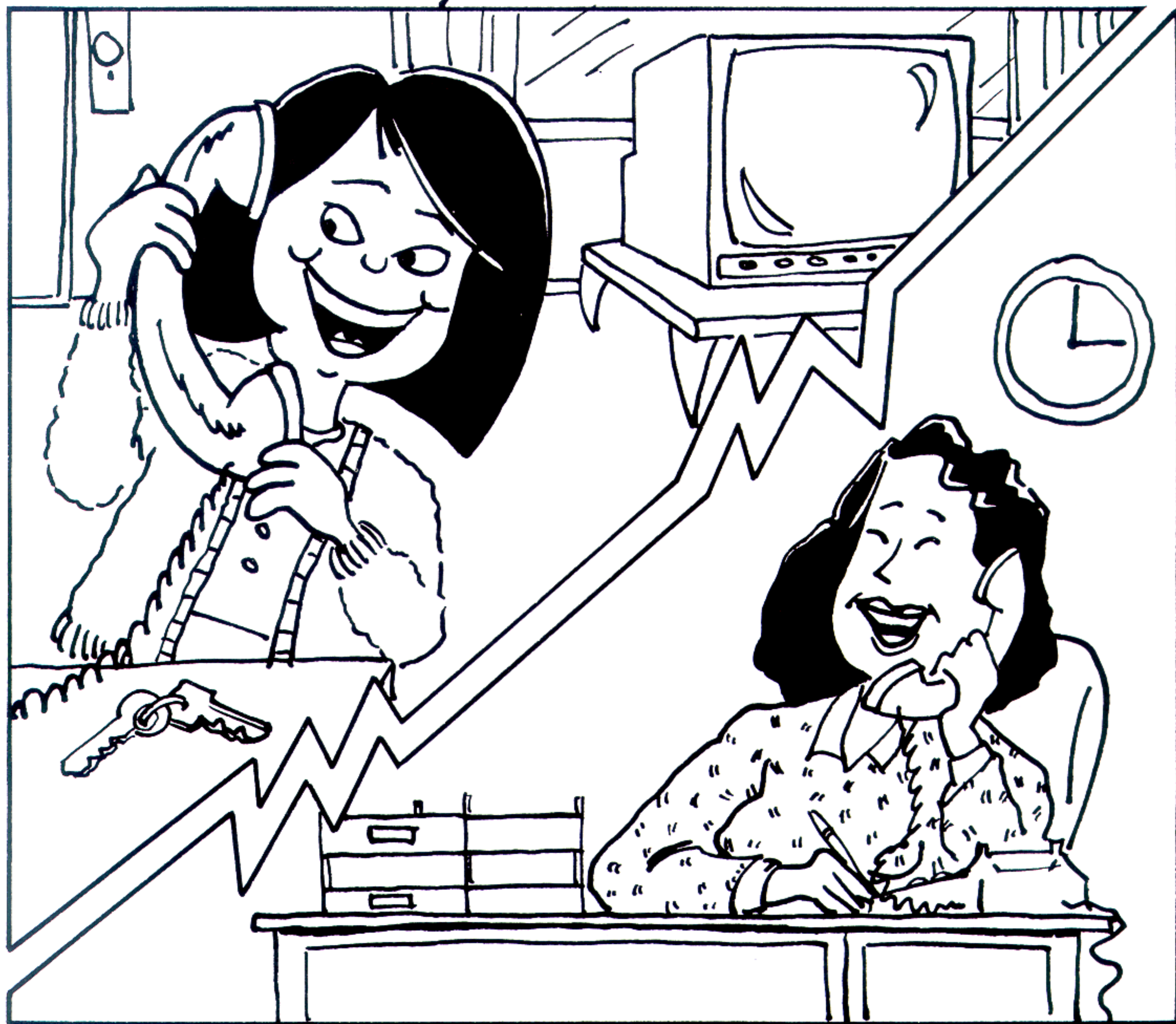




Know your first and last name, address, and phone number, plus area code.

If you are going to be home alone after school, call your mom or dad when you get home. Let them know you got home safely.

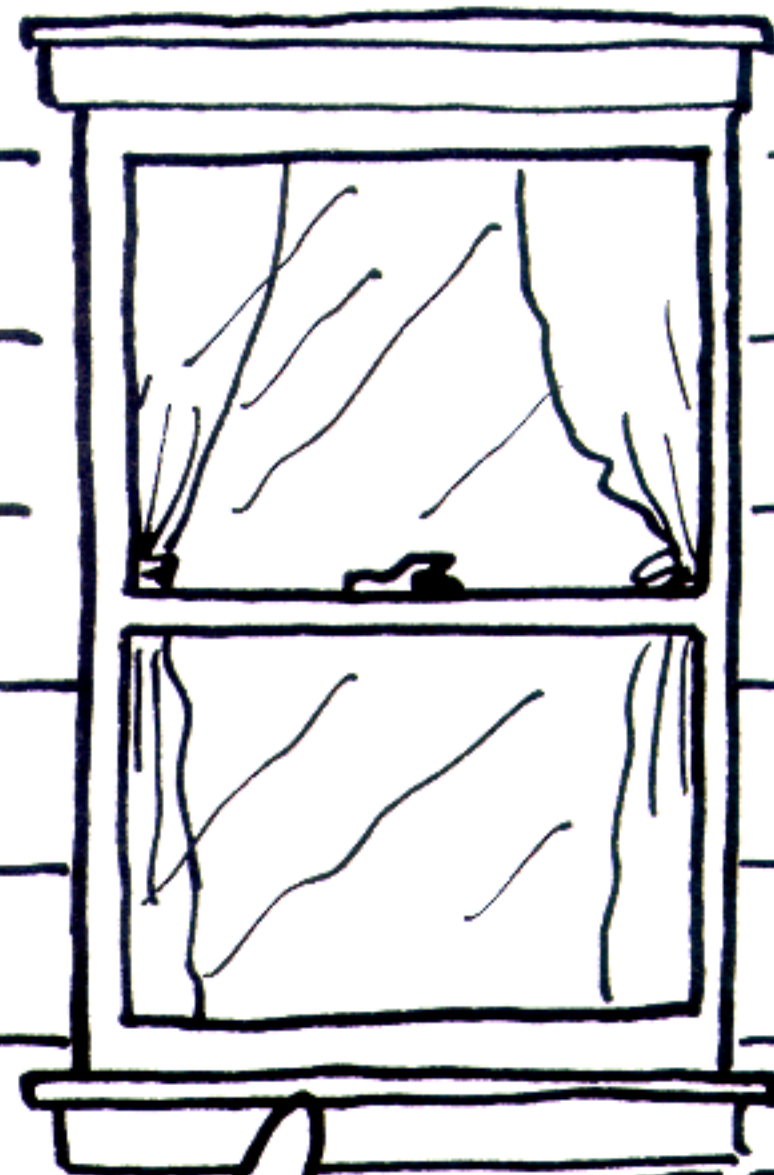
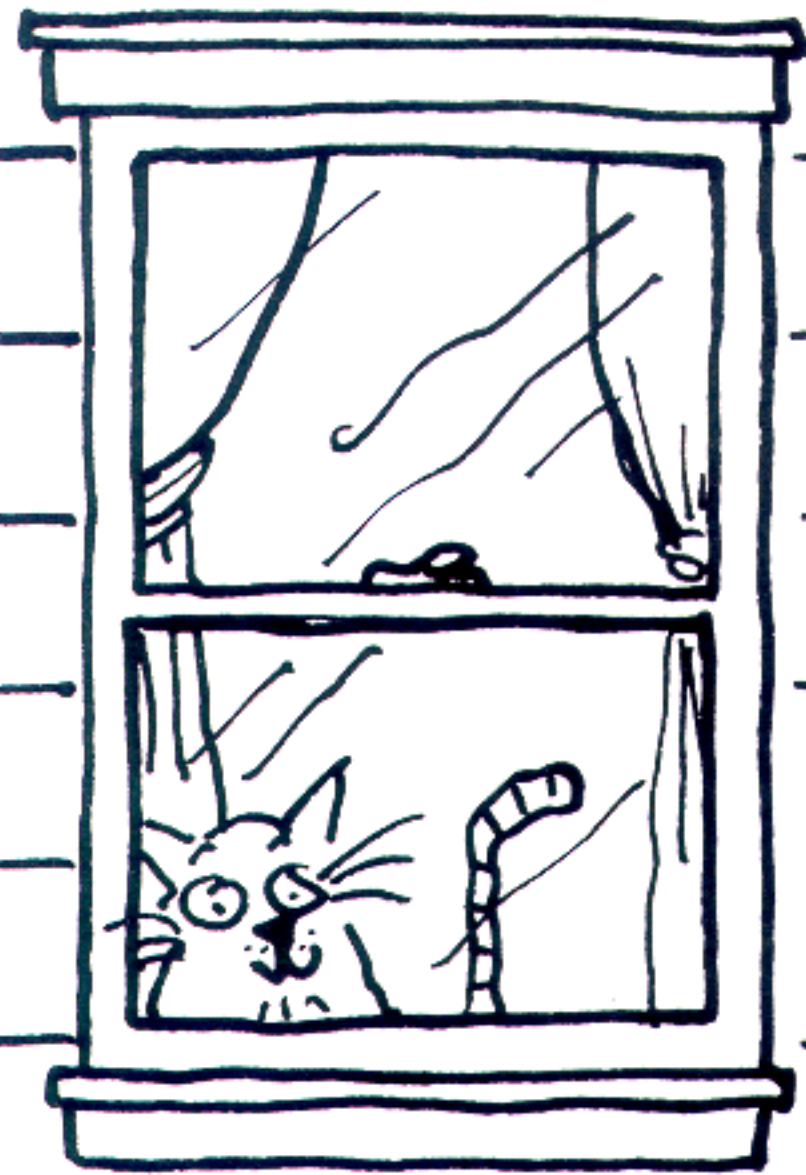


Ask your mom or dad, or another family member, to teach you ALL the telephone numbers you should know.

When you're away from home, always stay with friends.





Take the safest route to and from school. Don't go through areas you do not know well.



Never go anywhere with a stranger.
Say "NO," get away, and tell someone
you trust.



If a stranger calls, or comes to the door, never tell them you are home alone.



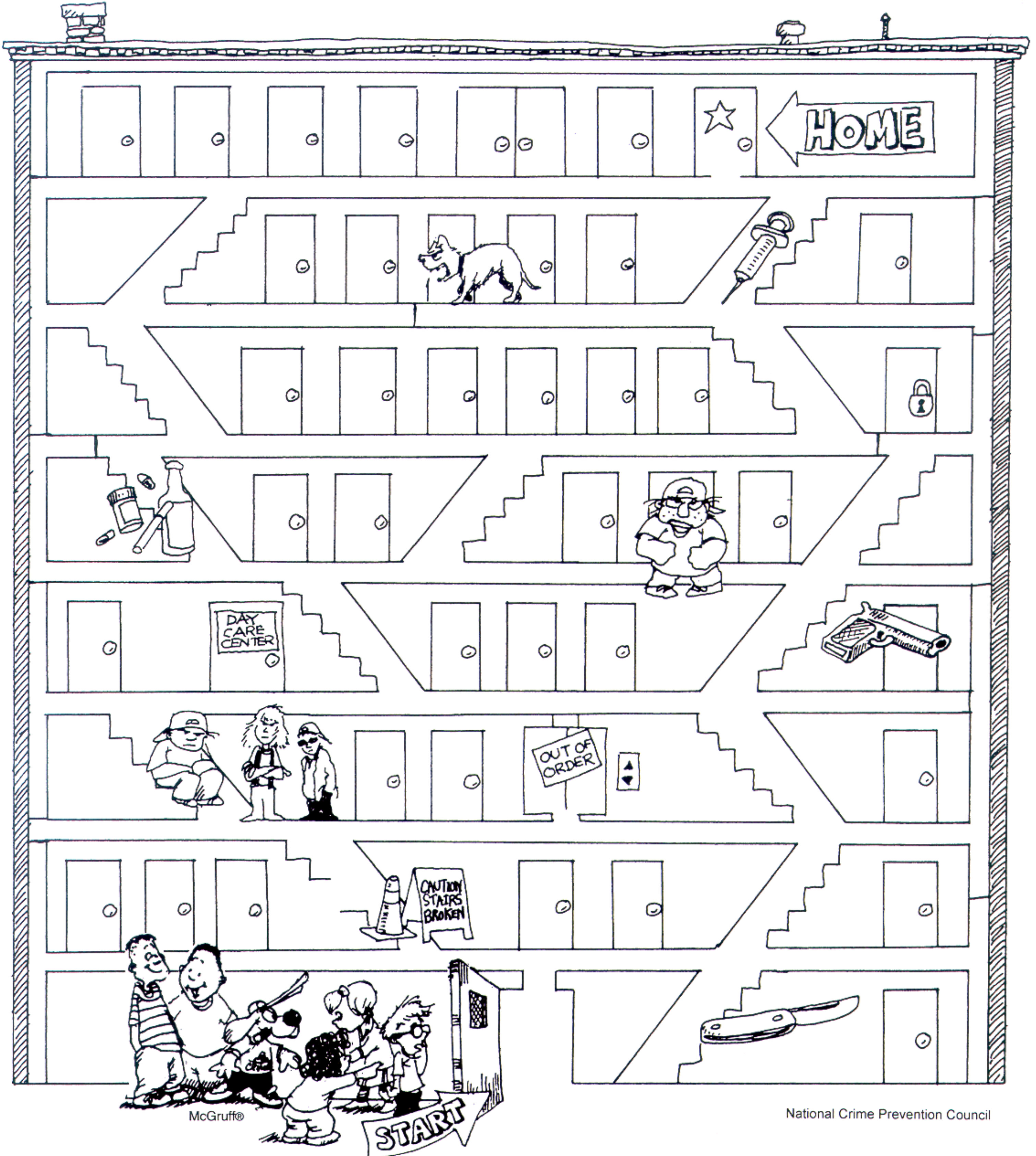
Never open a door to a stranger or someone you don't trust.

Tell a trusted adult what happened. If the stranger does not leave, call 9-1-1, or the police.

If something or someone makes you feel scared, always tell a family member, or someone else you trust.
