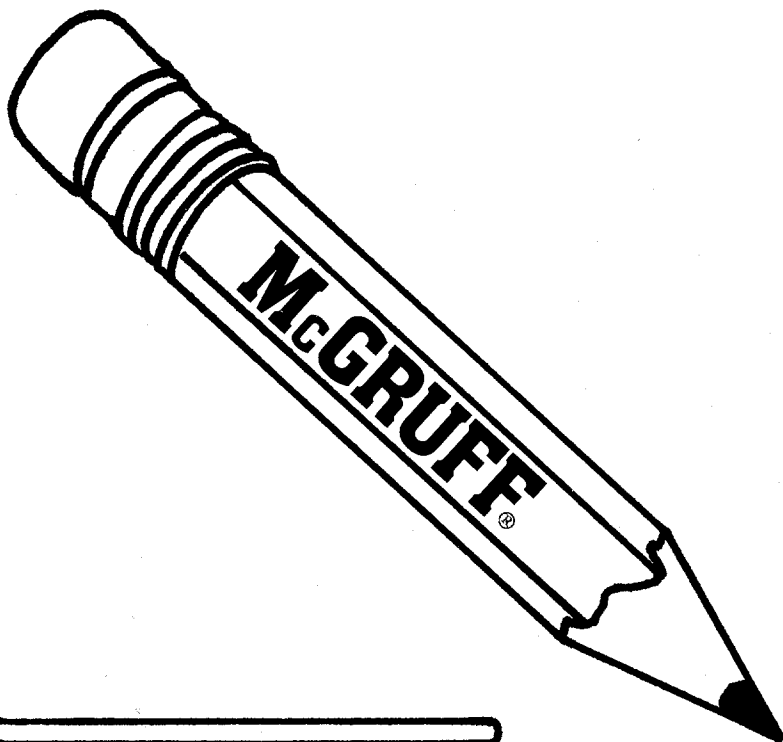

Laws.



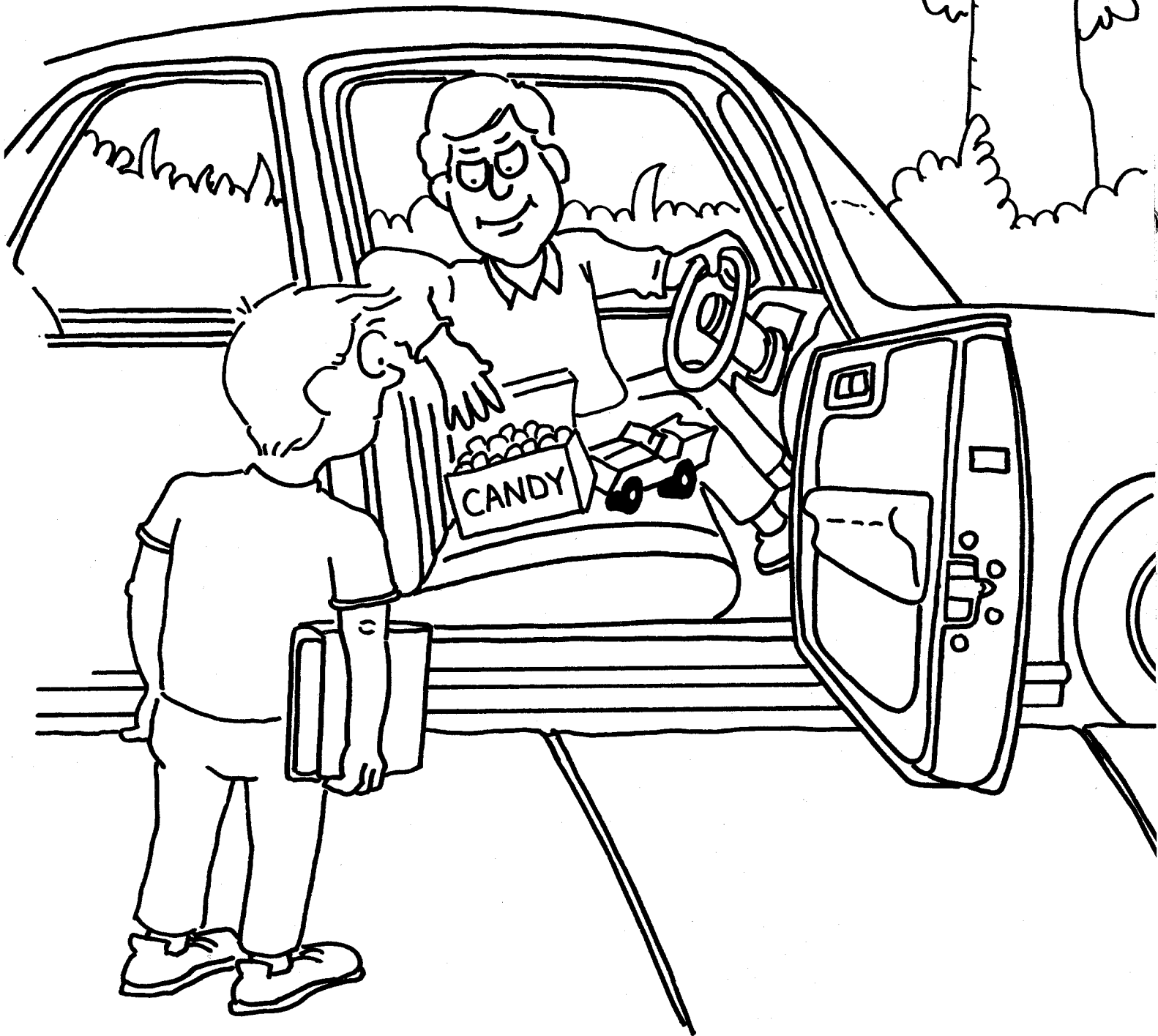
Breaking a Law

you know.

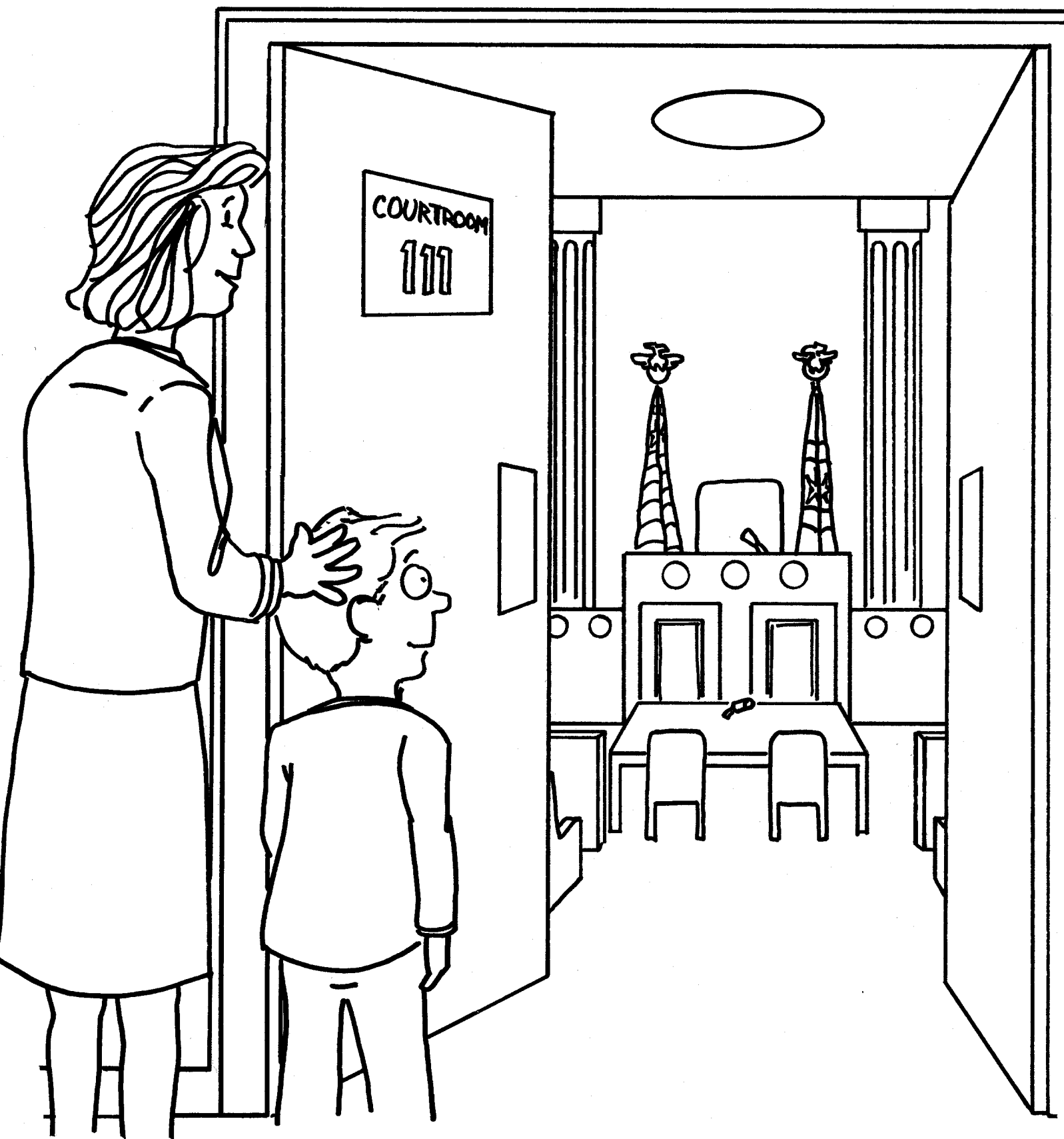

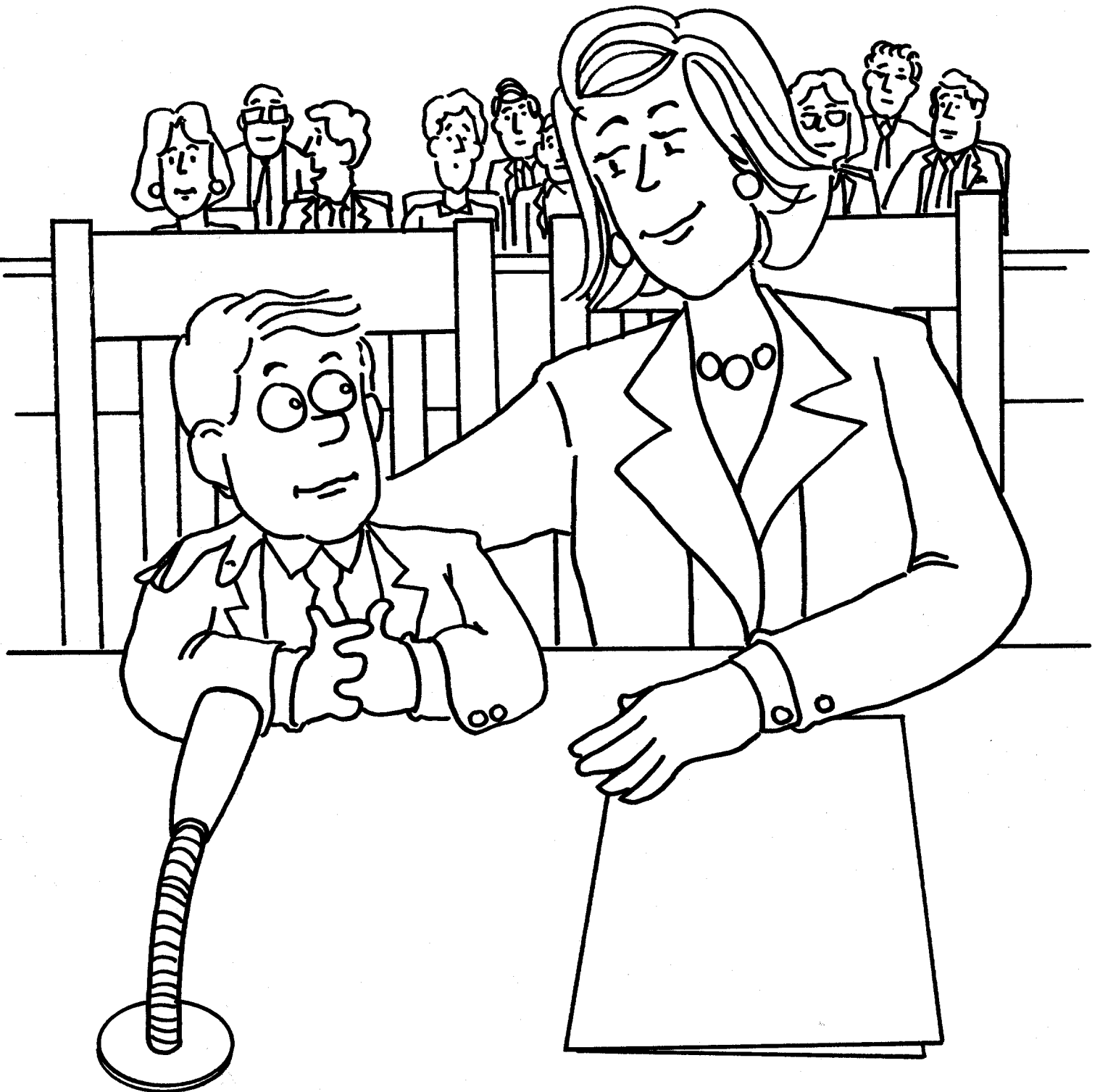
IF someone hurts you, the Police
can arrest that person.



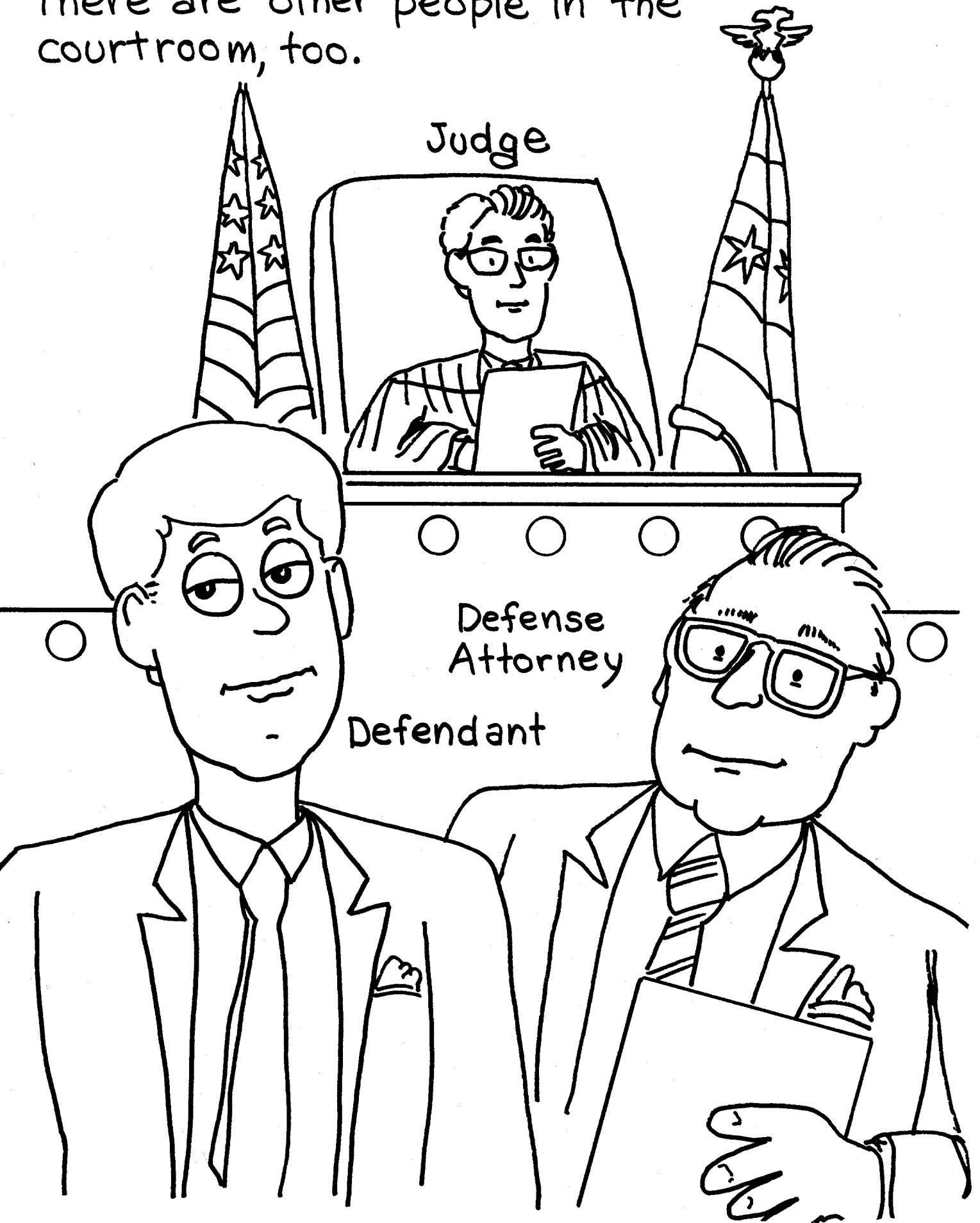
If the Police arrest the person who hurt you, sometimes you need to go to court to tell what happened.



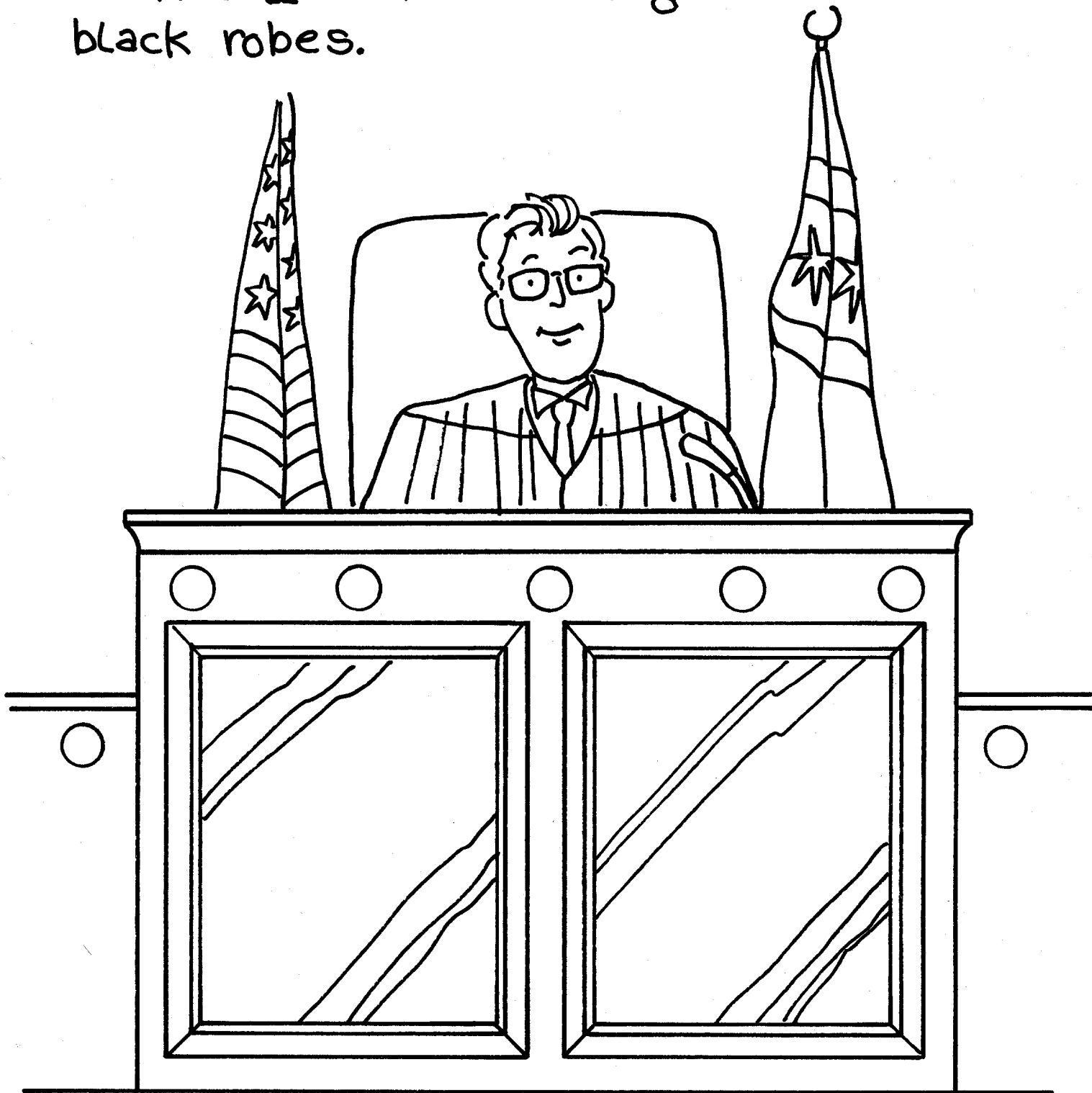
In court you will have a Lawyer with you. Your Lawyer is called a prosecutor.



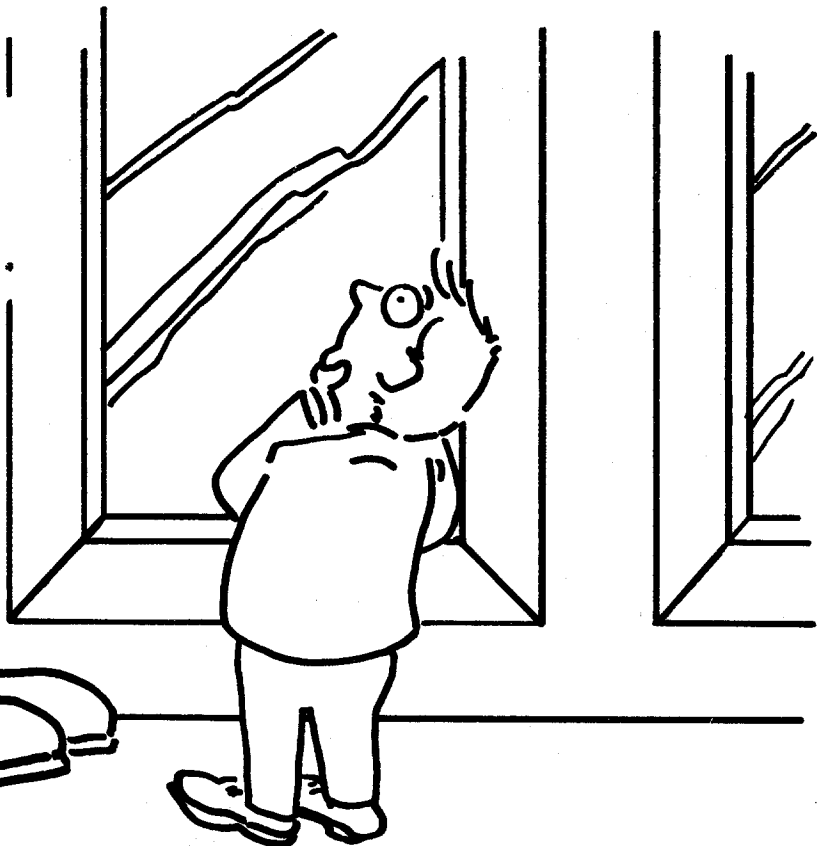
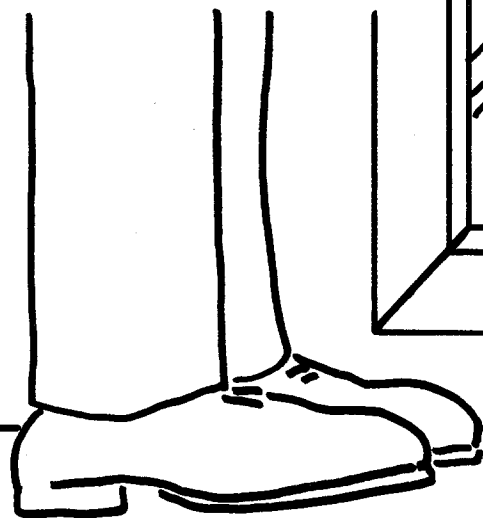
There are other people in the courtroom, too.



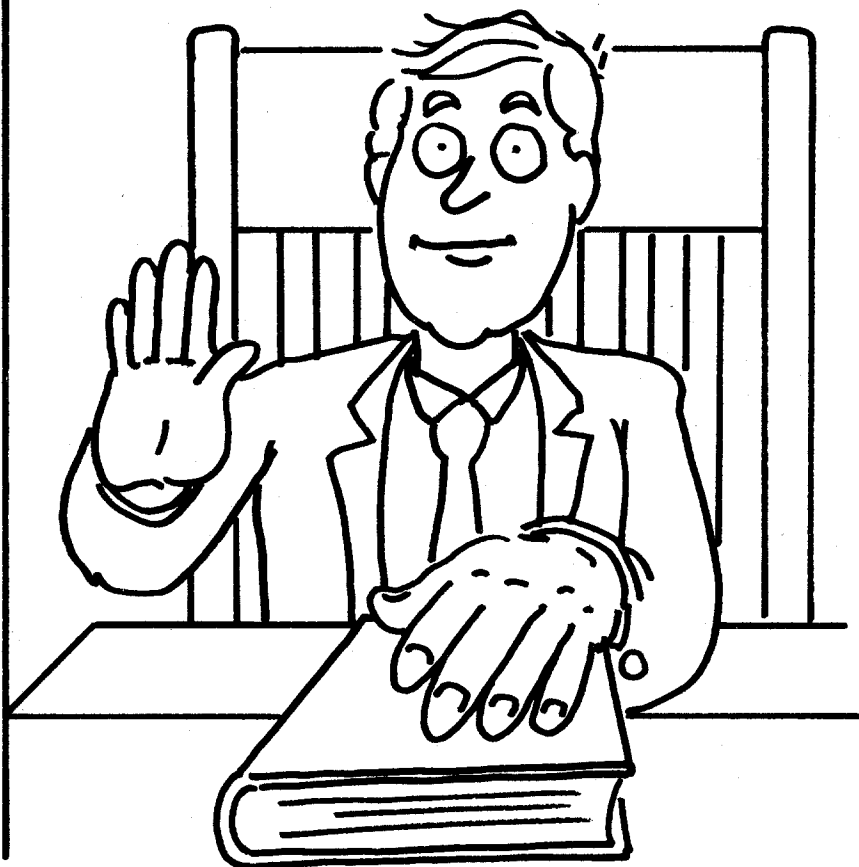
The judge may sit up high behind a desk called a bench. Judges wear black robes.

small and scared.



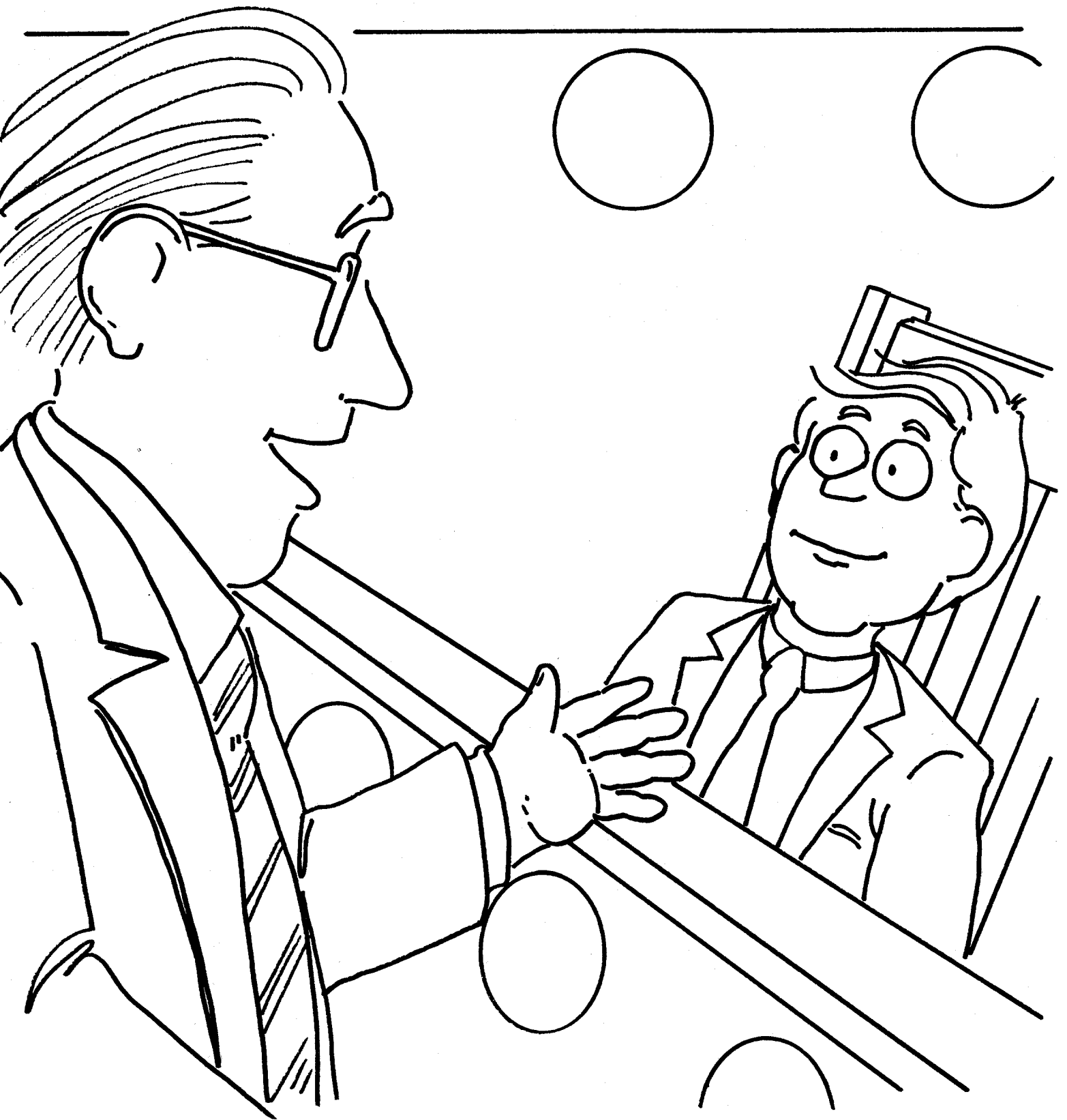
But remember,

will also ask you questions.



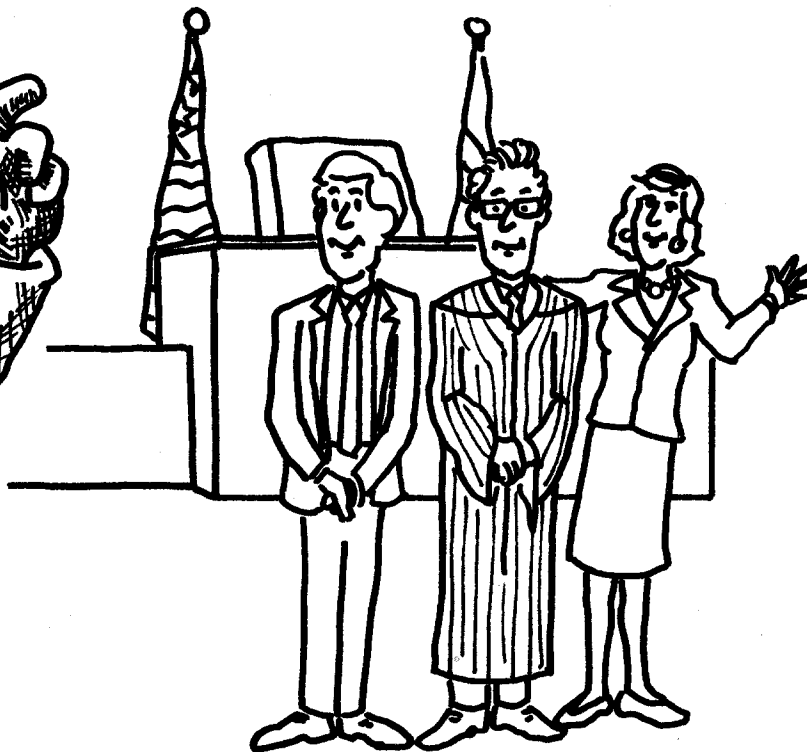
The judge will listen to you and to other people,

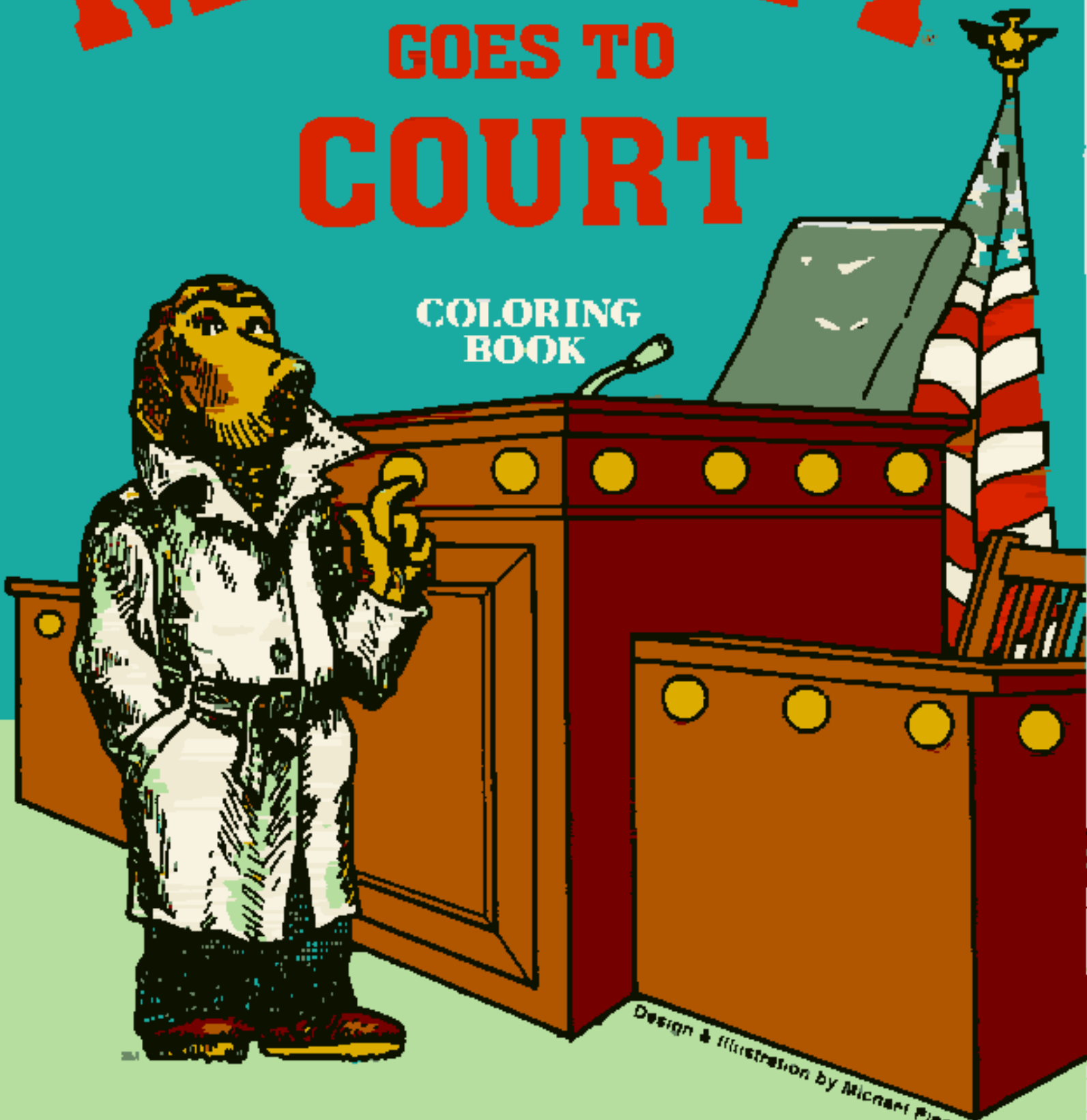
