










If the Police arrest the person who hurt you, sometimes you need to go to court to tell what happened.



In court you will have a lawyer with you. Your lawyer is called a prosecutor.






The judge may sit up high behind a desk called a bench. Judges wear black robes.




But remember, you have a very important job to do in court.




The prosecutor will ask you to sit in a special place. Your job is to tell the truth about what happened.
