

Approval of the Planning & Policy Committee's direction for business planning

The Strategic Plan's Scenario for Information Sharing outlined the IIJIS vision for integrated justice in Illinois. The subsequent gap analysis identified a number of candidate business issues whose implementation would be necessary to solve the problems identified in the Scenario. The Planning and Policy Committee has recommended grouping these business issues into the four functional areas outlined below and is seeking the Board's approval to begin developing a tactical plan for justice integration focusing on these information needs.

Candidate business issues identified in the gap analysis grouped according to functional area.

LEADS Improvements

- Ensure the "10-28" response contains driver's license numbers
- Ensure 10-second response to inquiries
- Ensure 24 hours currency of information
- Interface the "10-28" to the computerized hot files
- Improve CQH format and create one inquiry for subject history and status
- Develop an initial response that highlights officer safety information
- Ensure that all orders of protection and warrants are entered into LEADS
- Develop ways to access conditions of parole and probation as well as immigration status information
- Develop ways to access digital photographs

Criminal History Improvements

- Ensure felony upgrades are posted to CHRI
- Ensure juvenile station adjustments and dispositions are posted to CHRI
- Improve disposition reporting to the Bureau of Identification
- Convert the CHRI repository into a relational database to facilitate inquiries
- Eliminate the separate functions for Fingerprint Inquiry and Booking
- Eliminate the separate LEADS SID Inquiry after posting arrest to CHRI
- Provide access to CHRI Live Scan photos
- Develop a system to transfer Live Scan booking data to Counties to facilitate integration (Core Data Transfer)
- Create a means for county clerks to transmit electronic documents to other justice agencies

Incident Level Data

- Create access to statewide incident-level information
- Develop and adopt a standard incident report
- Develop and adopt a standard field contact report
- Develop and adopt a standard intelligence report
- Develop and adopt a standard traffic accident report
- Develop and adopt a standard traffic citation
- Develop a computer-aided dispatch (CAD) interface to records management systems

Infrastructure Improvements

- Ensure that all police vehicles in the State have MDCs
- Ensure that all mobile data systems have sufficient bandwidth to carry photos and incident data
- Ensure that all police departments have access to Live Scan technology
- Streamline the number of parallel data networks

Other initiatives to facilitate the sharing of justice information

- Utilize digital signature and electronic filing technologies
- Increase the use of video bond hearings
