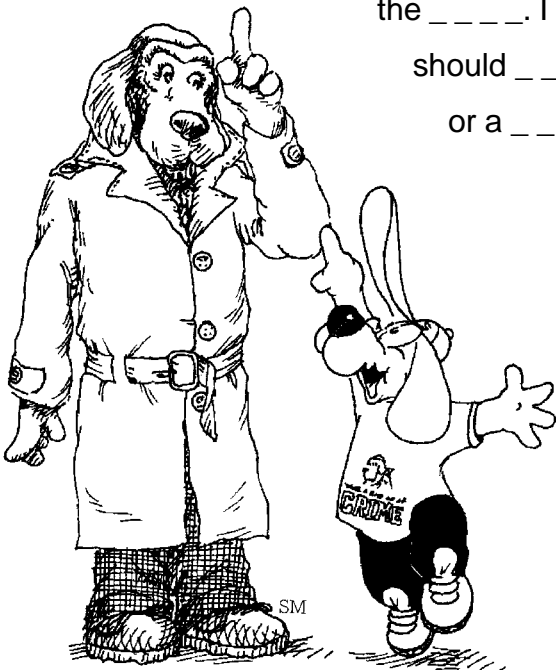

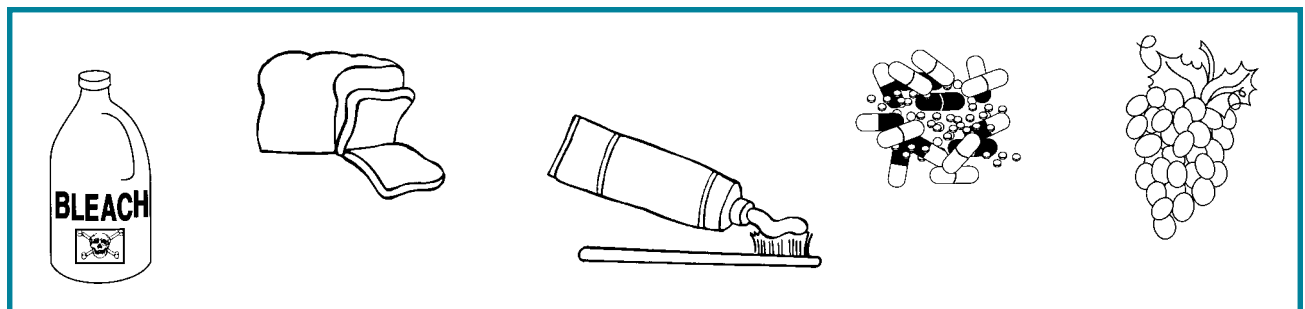

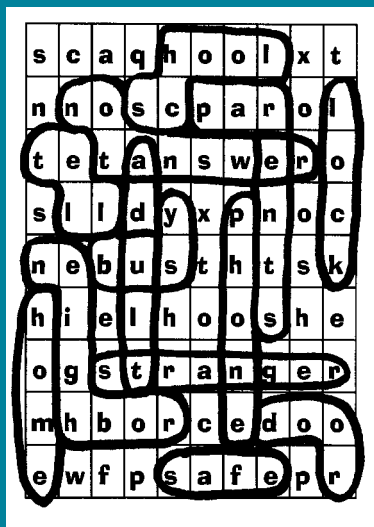
Which of these things are not safe? Draw a big "X" over those pictures. Color the pictures of those things that are safe and good for you.

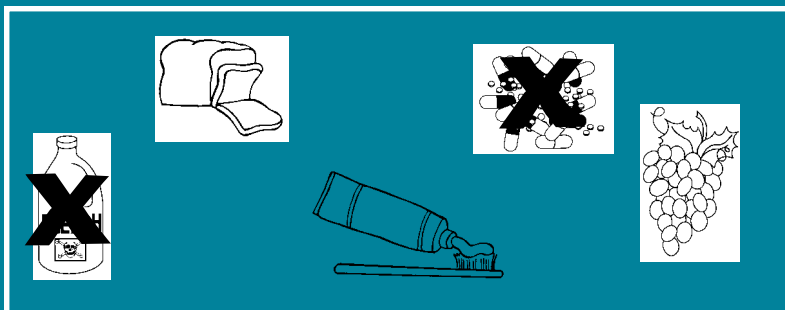

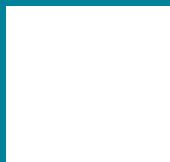
