- Purposes of sentencing embodied in the IL constitution, the Code of Corrections and as the purposes of SPAC:
- (1) prescribe sanctions proportionate to the seriousness of the offenses and permit the recognition of differences in rehabilitation possibilities along individual offenders;
  - (2) forbid and prevent the commission of offenses;
  - (3) prevent arbitrary or oppressive treatment of persons adjudicated offenders or delinquents; and
  - (4) restore offenders to useful citizenship.
